Angrecum sesquipedale

Angrecums are usually blooming at this time of year. The **genus Angraecum** contains about 220 **species**, some of them among most magnificent of all **orchids**. They belong to the subtribe Angraecinae and as such, do not possess **pseudobulbs** but have an ever growing **monopodial** stem or stems.

Most are **epiphytes**, but a few are **lithophytes**.

Tropical **Africa** and **Madagascar** contain the majority of the genus with outlying species in southeast **Asia**. But these orchids can also be found on the **Comoros**, the **Seychelles**, and the **Mascarenes**.
